

Overview

Baptist Christian Hospital was established in 1954 and was incorporated into the Emmanuel Hospital Association in 2004. Baptist Christian services include surgeries, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatric surgery, pathology, neurology, endodontics, digital x-ray, CT scans, ultrasound, endoscopy, and ECG. The hospital has an extensive outpatient department and a 24-hour emergency department and pharmacy. They have a nursing school as well as offering training in paramedical studies, health administration, and finance. The hospital also runs community health and development programs.

Overview

Founded in the 1930s, Chhatarpur Christian Hospital is now a 120-bed, full-service healthcare facility that provides care in general medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, dentistry, ophthalmology, ENT, and orthopedics. The facility hosts a nursing school where they train students from various parts of North India for future service as nurses, many at Chhatarpur Christian Hospital as well as other EHA hospitals. The hospital also has a Community Health & Development Project that seeks to improve health and living conditions of people in the surrounding villages.

Chinchpada Christian Hospital provides healthcare to the predominantly tribal population in the surrounding villages. Established in 1942, the hospital started out as a small clinic. Later it grew to a 15-bed hospital, and then was incorporated with EHA in 1976. The service priorities of the hospital include general medicine, pediatric care, obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedic services, dentistry, palliative care, and research. The hospital also conducts outreach clinics in surrounding villages.

They also provide nursing services and education. The hospital also runs community health and development programs.

Herbertpur offers services in the specialties of pediatric surgery, pediatrics, orthopedics, obstetrics and gynecology, ophthalmology, ENT and audiology, dermatology, dentistry, physiotherapy, as well as a program for children with disabilities. The nursing school trains students for future service at Herbertpur as well as other EHA hospitals. Their many Community Health Programs serve to provide rehabilitation for children with cerebral palsy, to improve literacy, to increase health awareness, to offer HIV testing, and to provide care for TB patients.
